The above information is not a complete list of coursework in each category. It should help you in determining if you have met the 6 quarter hour (or 4 credit semester) requirement for coursework in each of the above categories. For example: If you took 3 credits of biology and 3 credits of physics you have 6 credits and have met the minimum requirement in Natural Sciences. When you total all your coursework between the three areas you should have at least 50 quarter hours or 34 semester credits. Please use your best judgment when determining which of categories you coursework belongs.
